##### Disabled (residents of Ontario only)

6-17 years incl.	\$ 2. <sup>25</sup>
18 years and over	\$ 5. <sup>00</sup>

##### Seniors (residents of Ontario only)

65 years and over	\$ 8. <sup>00</sup>

#### DAY USE FEES - Per Vehicle: ( no overnight camping ) ( vehicle = canoe, boat, aircraft, snowmachine )

- Daily Vehicle Permit \$ 10.<sup>75</sup>
- Disabled ( Residents of Ontario only ) \$ 5.<sup>25</sup>
- Seniors ( Residents of Ontario only ) \$ 8.<sup>50</sup>
- Summer Vehicle Permit \$ 107.<sup>50</sup>
- Winter Vehicle Permit \$ 70.<sup>00</sup>
- Annual Vehicle Permit \$ 150.<sup>50</sup>
